STEPS BLIND PEDESTRIANS TAKE NAVIGATING SIDEWALKS

- 1 LOCATE THE STREET: USING TRAFFIC SOUNDS, CURBS/SLOPES, AND SURROUNDING STRUCTURES.
- 2 STREET RECOGNITION: MANY DEVELOP A MENTAL MAP
 IF INFORMATION IS NOT IN AN ACCESSIBLE FORMAT
- 3 INTERSECTION ASSESSMENT: USING KNOWLEDGE OF THE CROSSWALK + TRAFFIC SOUNDS.
- 4 CROSS THE ROADWAY: FACE THE OTHER CURB, LISTEN FOR SIGNALS OR A SURGE OF FOOT TRAFFIC.
