## Reporting Procedures for Spill Response



#### Containment Steps

Non-Reportable Spill

Reportable Spill





- Stay up wind of spill
- Wear proper PPE Set up cones or barricades
- Place absorbents on spill
- 6. Divert spill away from inlets or hodies of water

- Known material
- 2. Can be safely contained
- 3. On impervious service
- 4 Does not enter waters

- 1 Unknown material
- Do not feel safe
- 3 Into waters or storm sewer
- 4. Spills requiring state notification
